Coaching changes – The United States appointed a new head coach midway through the campaign, sparking a tactical reset that produced a five-match winning streak.

Injury woes – Panama lost its leading striker to a hamstring injury during the third matchday,

Two inter-confederation play-offs (Asia vs. CONCACAF; South America vs. Oceania) slated for March 2022.

Potential friendly matches for teams that missed direct slots, offering a chance to rebuild ahead of the next World Cup cycle.

Early discussions about a revamped qualifying format for the 2026 tournament, which will include more CONCACAF participants as the region expands its allocation.

Fans can anticipate a focused look at squad development, especially for the United States and Canada, both eager to avoid another early exit. Meanwhile, the Caribbean nations are likely to lobby for a more inclusive schedule that mitigates travel strain.
